

DIY Displays – Safety First

Tips on Setting Up:

- Think ahead and familiarise yourself with EVERY firework.
- Read the firework label instructions. If there is no label, then it may be an illegal product, which may not conform to British Standards. Contact your local Police or Trading Standards as to what you should do with this item. Please DO NOT be tempted to light this product, you do so at your own risk.
- Place upright on flat ground. Ensure firework will not fall over. The ABSOLUTE MINIMUM should be to place onto a flat board with bricks to secure the firework from toppling over.
- You DO NOT have to remove any paper from either the top or the side of the firework. The powerful launch from each tube will burst through the paper on top. We suggest you straighten fuses in daylight, in a dry place with time to familiarise yourself with the firework, rather than at the last possible moment (some fuses are covered with tape, which may require a pair of scissors/knife to free from the side). When straightening the fuse from the firework, be careful NOT TO pull out the fuse from inside the firework.
- Locate tip of fuse, light tip of free end at arms length and retire immediately. If you DO NOT follow this straight forward advice, when it comes to lighting this firework, the pressure to keep the display flowing could lead to mistakes. (i.e. lighting the wrong end of the fuse) If you haven't guessed what this means already, the firework will most likely ignite with the operator standing only a few feet away.
